61 Credit Hours

The Associate of Arts in Worship Leadership Studies is a fully accredited, two-year, college level program designed to introduce students to worship ministries leadership in a pastoral setting. The AA provides the general education overview, biblical knowledge, theological competency, and pastoral skills for any student preparing for full-time, part-time, or volunteer ministry in a local church. This degree meets the educational standards for credentialing with the Assemblies of God.

COURSES

Part 1. General Education Core – 27 credits

Two English courses (6 credits): ENG 124 Research and Rhetoric is required. Two Social Science courses (6 credits): GBS 112 Cultural Anthropology is required; YDEV 337 Sociology of American Youth is recommended for second requirement. One math/natural science courses (3 credits): MATH 110 Personal Finance is required. Communications (6 credits): COMM 152 Interpersonal Communication & PMIN 252 Homiletics is required. One history course (3 credits): HIST 212 History of Global Christianity is required. Practicum (3 credits): MUS 488 Music Internship 1 (3 credits) is required.
